Who Can Enter:

The contest is open to Primary and High School Students across the Bega Valley Shire.

What do I have to Design:

Entrants will design a bus wrap for the Cruiseship shuttle buses using the theme Colour our Coast represnting the Sapphire Coast and all it's beauty! The key to creating a winning design for the "**Colour Our Coast**" competition is to capture the essence of the Sapphire Coast's natural beauty and unique character. By using bold colors and striking imagery, the bus wrap can showcase all that this spectacular region has to offer.

Suggestion for a Winning Design:

- A design with large elements will look better than a design with lots of small complicated elements
- Try not to overcrowd your design
- Bright bold colours look best

Rules and Requirements

- Each entrant must complete the entry form
- Entrants must use the provided templates and be submitted on **white paper in an A3** format. There are four templates in total.
- Newspaper clippings, glitter, copyrighted material is not acceptable
- Inappropriate or offensive artwork will not be accepted

Please note: Consideration should be given to the local Aboriginal community; therefore it is highly recommended that consultation be sought for the Aboriginal designs.

Submitting work & Deadline for Entries:

All entries must be received and submitted to Sapphire Coast Buslines by 16th October 2023 Completed submissions can be mailed or dropped off in person to:-39 Redfern Close, Pambula NSW 2548

How will the Design be Judged?

The competition will be conducted in 2 rounds. **Round 1:**

All participants group or individual submit their designs to the school. The head teacher from each class then selects the 10 best designs for submission.

Round 2:

A judging panel consisting of SCB staff, and local dignitaries vote on the favourite design. The two designs that receive the most votes is the winner of the competition. Judges will evaluate each design based on the following criteria.

- Did the entrant complete the entry from?
- Does the design represent the Sapphire Coast local area and its culture?
- Is the design eye-catching?
- Does the entry meet all the rules and requirement?

Prizes

- One winner will be chosen from Primary School and high school
- The winning designs will be displayed on the buses for the next 3 years
- \$500 donation to the winning school's art department
- There will be Individual and class prizes
- The winning participant(s) and school name are displayed on the bus
- All the participating students will receive a certificate of participation
